Herons' Curriculum Newsletter

<u>Seasons</u>

Unit 2

Mathematics

The children will continue to develop their understanding and confidence to use numbers within 10, whilst building their fluency skills. We will be focusing on addition and subtraction! We will learn our number bonds to 10, add numbers together, subtract numbers and learn about fact families. Maths learning will use a range of strategies and resources whilst deepening their understanding through questioning and reasoning opportunities.

<u>English</u>

In English, the children will continue forming simple sentences, focusing on capital letters, fingers spaces and full stops. The formation of both lower and upper case letters will continue to be practised amongst different writing opportunities. Children will have the opportunity to write for different purposes and will be linked to our topic 'Seasons'. During Phonics, we will be starting to learn new sounds as we start to grow the code. Herons will continue to have a group reading sessions three times a week and will bring home a reading book from these sessions. **Phonics reading books – Changed every Thursday**

Library books – Changed every Wednesday Rainbow Reads – Counted on a Thursday Please make sure your child's reading books and diaries are in school every day.



<u>Tapestry</u>

A home learning task will be added to Tapestry <u>every Friday</u>. The focus will be Phonics tasks that are carefully linked to their learning in class. This is so each child can continue to make progress with their reading and to give you insight into their learning too.

<u>Science</u>

This unit we will be starting our topic about 'Materials'. We will be learning how to classify materials using prepared tables and sorting rings. We will be testing different materials to see which materials are waterproof and which are absorbent. We will also think about why certain materials are appropriate for different purposes and other materials are not.

<u>Humanities</u>

This half term we will be focusing on Geography and we will be exploring the topic of 'Seasons'. We will be focusing on the weather and how it changes through each season. The children will have chance to learn skills on how to predict and measure the weather and will even have a go at documenting this on a weather chart.

Art & Design Technology

Our second Art topic will be about print making and they will have the chance to create printing art work with many different techniques. The children will develop their use of using a sketchbook and use this to document their development of skills within this topic.

Personal, Social and Health Education

For our second topic of the year, we will be focussing on 'Feeling Safe'. The children will learn about safe and unsafe adults, secrets which are ok to keep and ones that we should share and we will even get to interview a safe adult who is our very own PCSO.

Please make sure that your child has their names in all of their uniform and a water bottle that is clearly labelled too.
