



Meeting the needs of a new community

Anker Valley Academy is being built to meet the needs of new housing developments in the locality; the school will be at the heart of this new community.

Fierté Multi-Academy Trust, a local Trust that already sponsors seven successful schools in Tamworth and Burton, is sponsoring the new academy, working alongside Staffordshire Local Authority.

The two-storey school is being built at a cost of more than £5 million, funded by developer contributions and the government. As well as a number of classrooms, it will also have playing fields and a playground for outdoor PE. With its proximity to the River Anker, the Fierté MAT will put an emphasis on outdoor education, with pupils learning from the rich surroundings.

The school will be a new 210-place free school that is due to open in September 2021 for Nursery and Reception, with one class per year group, growing year-on-year up to Year 6, before children move on to High School (the school sits within the catchment area of The Rawlett School).

Nursery, holiday, before and after school provision will also be available for working parents and carers through an established provider run by the Trust, Our Pride Our Joy. This successfully operates in the Trust's existing academies.

Offers will be made on 16/04/2021. If we have not entered into a funding agreement with the Secretary of State opening the school by that date, they will be conditional offers and will be confirmed once we have a signed funding agreement.


Nursery applications
