Reading at Home

We would love for the children to be reading daily at home with an adult; this could be their phonics book, their library book or a book from home. It is important that the children try to read their **phonics book at least three times each week**, to aid with the development of their early reading skills and to link to the work being completed in school.

On a Friday, Mrs Free and Miss Garrett will count how many times reading has been recorded in the Reading Diaries. It is important that this includes a comment, as well as the title and the date (please see the front of the Reading Diary for help with this). In the Reading Diary you may record reading of school books and books from home.

For every 25 reads the children will receive a special certificate.

Red—25 reads Orange—50 reads Yellow—75 reads Green—100 reads Blue—125 reads Indigo—150 reads Violet—175 reads Gold—200 reads

For achieving the Gold Reader certificate the children will be given a special certificate, badge and prize.
