

Dragonflies Curriculum Newsletter

Under the Sea

Summer Term 2 2023

Mathematics

This term we will consolidate out knowledge of numbers to 10, including the composition of each number. We will continue to subitise and recall number bonds to 5 and 10. The children will continue to practise counting beyond 20. They will compare quantities up to 10 in different contexts, recognising when one quantity is greater than, less than or the same as the other quantity. The children will explore and represent patterns within numbers to 10, including evens and odds, double facts and how quantities can be distributed equally.

Literacy

The children will begin forming simple sentences, focusing on capital letters fingers spaces and full stops. The formation of both lower and upper case letters will continue to be practised and any additional practise of this at home would be beneficial to support their transition to Year 1.

During Phonics we will continue to secure Phase 4 of the Reception Little Wandle phonics programme in preparation for starting Year 1 in September.

Dragonflies will continue to have group reading sessions three times a week and will bring home a reading book from these sessions.

Library books—Changed every Friday Rainbow Reads are counted on a Thursday

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

This half term we will begin to prepare the children for their transition to Year 1. They will have the opportunity to meet their new teacher and to visit their new classroom on Monday 17th July. We will also continue to learn about the school Virtues and share our thoughts and feelings during weekly circle time activities with Daisy the Dragonfly.



Communication & Language

We will read stories about sea creatures, such as Tiddler, Commotion in the Ocean, Shark in the Park and The Rainbow Fish. The children will offer explanations as to why things might happen making use of recently introduced vocabulary. They will express their ideas and feelings about experiences using full sentences, a range of tenses and conjunctions.


Expressive Arts & Design

The children will create pictures and models of the characters within the stories we read, including Tiddler, Rainbow Fish, Commotion in the Ocean, Shark in the Park and Snail and the Whale.

Understanding the World

We will learn about how environments can be influenced by human activity and how we can protect sea creatures and their habitats. We will learn about the different ocean habitats, including the coral reef. We will find out how to stay safe in the sun and near water too.
