In Maths this week we have been learning about 2D shapes and their properties, the children are good at naming shapes and manipulating shapes to make their own patterns and pictures. The children have used a range of language features such as prepositions and adjectives to make their description sound exciting for the reader and give a detailed description of what their house looks like. In Maths, we have completed a new topic of measurement for Height and Length. The children have done well at using the correct terminology and using standard and non-standard units of measure. In the wider curriculum, the children have been learning to type a sentence on Microsoft Word, started to identify a range of emotions in PSHE and in PE they have started to learn about athletics.
