Herons' Curriculum Newsletter

Summer Term 1 2023

Welcome back to a brand new half term!

<u>Mathematics</u>

The children will continue be completing their topic about Place Value within 50 by estimating numbers on a number line and finding 1 more and 1 less than a given number. The children will then move on to learning about length and height, mass and volume, position and direction and money. The children will explore each of these areas of learning through practical resources and will make links to real-life scenarios.

<u>English</u>

In English, we will be basing our learning all around the fantastic story 'In Every House on Every Street'. The children will firstly be learning all about descriptive language as they describe different types of homes. They will then pull together all of their learning and understanding to create a non-chronological report about houses.

During Phonics, we will be continuing to grow the code, as we learn alternative graphemes and start focussing on preparation for the phonics screening check. Herons will continue to have group reading sessions three times a week and will bring home a reading book from these sessions.

Phonics reading books — Changed every Thursday Library books— Changed every week. Rainbow Reads— Counted every Thursday Please make sure your child's reading books and diaries are in school every day.



<u>Tapestry</u>

A home learning task will be added to Tapestry <u>each Friday</u>, this is to be completed by the following Friday. Please ask if you are having any issues with logging on or uploading photographs and Mrs Free or Miss Matthews will be happy to help.

<u>Science</u>

This half term we will be focusing on 'Plants' in our Science lessons every week. The children will be learning about wild flowers and the different types of trees. They will also be learning about the different parts of a plant whilst having the opportunity to grow their own. They will then be going on a walk to identify the different types of wild flowers and trees in their local area.

<u>Humanities</u>

This half term we will be learning about 'The Story of Our Local Area'. Previously they have learnt about Sir Robert Peel and now they will be learning about another influential historical figure, William McGregor. They will find out during this topic, why he is important to Tamworth, where he lived and identify the changes from when he was alive to now.

Art & Design Technology

Our fifth Art topic will be about 'Bird Making'. The children will be exploring how to turn a piece of paper into a 3D sculpture of a bird. They will learn different folding, cutting and rubbing techniques to make their sculptures look realistic.



Personal, Social and Health Education

For our fifth topic of the year, the children will be learning all about the different types of feelings we experience. They will be learning about what effects different feelings have on their body and how we can manage some of these feelings.

Please make sure that your child has their names in all of their uniform and a water bottle that is clearly labelled too.
